Why not join our special train direct to Edinburgh from the convenience of your local station. The coaches date from the late 1950's and early 1960's. We travel north over the Vale of York, with views over to the White Horse of Kilburn. From the train you have the best view of Durham Cathedral, see The Angel of the North at Gateshead and the great view of Newcastle as we cross the Tyne. We then enjoy mile after mile of sea views, along the rugged Northumberland coastline with views over Bamburgh Castle, Alnmouth and Lindisfarne. At Berwick-upon-Tweed a great panoramic view beholds as we cross the Royal Border Bridge. The sea views continue along the Lothian Coastline. We arrive in Edinburgh at lunchtime for a break of around 5 hours giving ample time to explore the delights of this historic city, one of the world's most attractive capital cities. Or you can choose to stay on board and for £10 travel further North over the impressive Forth and Tay railway bridges to Royal Dundee for a break of around 2 hours.

TRAVEL DETAILS

In 1989, people throughout the country were horrified that the world famous Settle & Carlisle railway line was threatened with closure. That year the Green Party ran a protest train to highlight its plight. Now 21 years later, the reprieved route is a key railway line in the North. Rail services have improved and huge freight trains take traffic off the roads. Our tour offers the rare chance to take a superb scenic circular tour by heritage train direct from your local station. We travel north to Yorkshire and travel the full length of the Settle & Carlisle line past the remains of Kirkstall Abbey, through the market town of Skipton to the dramatic mountain landscape, Ingleborough, Penygent and Wherside. We descend to the beautiful Vale of Eden, through the market town of Appleby to Carlisle. Carlisle 'the border city' boasts good restaurants, a castle, beautiful cathedral and historic buildings carved from its famous red sandstone. After a 3 hour break we return via the beautiful Tyne Valley Line, crossing Hadrian's Wall we reach the narrow wooded valleys, and the grouse moors of Hexham, the source of the River Tyne. We follow the river down stream to its broad tidal reaches at Blaydon. We pass the Metro Centre and take the freight spur to Gateshead to join the East Coast Main Line and The Angel of the North. At Durham have a spectacular view over the cathedral and historic city. Then on over the Vale of York with views to the White Horse of Kilburn and back home to the Midlands.
