## Lighter Fruity Reds

- 24. Merlot, Finca El Picador (Chile)** £3.95 £14.95  
Soft on the palate, but packed with flavours of plum and black berry fruit and just a hint of spicy coconut.
- 25. Malbec, Pampas del Sur (Argentina)** £3.95 £14.95  
A rich wine, with layers of dark fruit, fragrance and spice. A great match for hearty full-flavoured dishes.
- 26. Epoto Tempranillo, Castilla y Leon (Spain)** £4.25 £15.95  
Soft, round black fruit flavours with an edge of Iberian spice. Think of this as a mini-Rioja.
- 27. L'aristocrate Grenache-Shiraz (France)** £4.75 £16.75  
A smooth jammy red with a red berry bouquet. Soft on the palate.
- 28. Cinsaut-Cabernet, Drakensberg Estate (South Africa)** £15.95  
Juicy and fruit-laden, this is a blend of dark stone-fruit and blackberry with a slightly sweet, moreish finish.
- 29. Nero d'Avola 2008, Lamura (Sicily)** £16.95  
Made from 100% Nero d'Avola grapes, the indigenous Sicilian grape. Lamura Nero d'Avola is soft, approachable and easy to drink.
- 30. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Taverna Nova (Italy)** £17.95  
Rich in colour but soft and warming on the palate. Full of vibrant raspberry fruit with a hint of thyme on the finish.
- 31. Fleurie Domaine Gry-Sablon, Beaujolais Cru (France)** £13.95 £24.95  
The Gamay grape gives good colour and soft and easy summer fruits on the palate.

## Fuller Flavoured Reds

- 32. Cabernet Sauvignon, Los Vilos (Chile)** £15.95  
Ripe fruit, soft cassis flavours, and a well rounded finish with hints of raspberry and plum.
- 33. Shiraz-Cabernet, Sandford Estate (Australia)** £4.50 £17.50  
Concentrated blackberry and damson fruit, with great structure and a whiff of pepper on the nose.
- 34. Le Pigeoulet de Brunier (France) V** £17.95  
This wine is mellow and warm just like a miniature Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Raspberry and black plum flavors, well balanced with lemon-squirt acidity and a long finish
- 35. Cranford Private Selection Merlot (Australia)** £5.25 £20.95  
Mainly Barossa fruit is used here to give amazing ripeness of rich plum laden Merlot fruit. Soft and silky with some weight.
- 36. Zinfandel, Angels Flight (California)** £17.50  
Spicy rich, ripe Zinfandel from California packed full with delicious raspberry, strawberry and blackberry fruit flavours.

37. **Periquita, JM da Fonseca (Portugal)** £18.80  
Strawberries, blueberries, black currant and violet.s. On the palate fruity, balanced with soft tannins – from Portugal's oldest winery
38. **Pinotage, Avondale Estate (South Africa) VO** £20.50  
Full-bodied, with plenty of dark stone-fruit, and a mouth-filling array of mulberries and redcurrant fruit.
39. **Grenache-Shiraz, Hugo Wines (Australia)** £21.95  
Produced from unirrigated vines in McLaren Vale, this has a spicy red berry character with a hint of black pepper.
40. **Private Selection Shiraz, Craneford (Australia) V** £20.95  
Rich, spicy and full-bodied Shiraz from John Zilm, one of the Barossa Valley's top producers.

## Oak-matured Reds

41. **Cabernet Sauvignon, Gougenheim** £5.50 £22.95  
**Tupungato (Argentina) V**  
In a different class – deep and richly flavoured, with ripe cassis fruit, chocolate, and beautifully integrated oak.
42. **Pinot Noir, Killara Park (Australia)** £21.95  
Deliciously fruit-driven Pinot - vibrant raspberry and strawberry fruit, subtle vanilla oak and a rousing finish.
43. **Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Muerza (Spain) V** £28.95  
A superbly structured wine, packed with flavours of cherry, tobacco and spice. One of the oldest Bodegas in Rioja.
44. **Chianti Classico, Villa Cafaggio (Italy)** £15.50 £29.95  
Complex nose of black cherries, minerals, pine needles, deliciously zippy acidity that carries flavours of strawberries and plums
45. **Chateaufneuf du Pape "Telegramme" 2003/04 (France) V** £34.95  
The second wine from Domaine de Vieux Telegraphe, big concentrated fruit character with a lovely spicy finish.
46. **Chateau Pindefleurs Grand Cru St Emilion 2000 (France)** £44.95  
Classic rich Merlot and Cabernet Franc blend from a very well managed Chateau owned by Christian Dior's cousin.
47. **Beaune 1er Cru Aux Coucherais 2002 Machard de Gramont (France)** £34.95  
Mature Burgundy showing lovely Pinot Noir character of dark cherries.
48. **Chateau Gruaud Larose 2me cru St Julien 1999 (France)** £70.00  
On the nose it has sweet blackcurrant and cherry fruit. The palate has bags of structure, with plenty of sweet, ripe, concentrated fruit.
49. **Brookman Merlot, Clarendon Hills 1999 (Australia)** £60.00  
Reveals a chocolate espresso roasted nose, full body, deep, concentrated flavours.  
This is an outstanding wine with plenty of smokiness, berry fruit and a lush, heady texture.

## Sparkling Wines and Champagne

50. **Prosecco, Vetricano Adria Vini (Italy)** £18.95  
Crisp apple with a hint of sweet ripeness which makes it an appealing aperitif for all tastes.
51. **Pelorus, Cloudy Bay (New Zealand)** £5.95 £29.95  
From the Cloudy Bay Estate with the backing of Veuve Clicquot. Made using the Champagne method. The deliciously crisp palate displays toasty, creamy complexity, enhanced by a lingering nutty finish.
52. **Georges Gardet Brut Special (Champagne)** £18.95 £34.50  
Produced almost entirely from Premier and Grand Cru vineyards – delicious, elegant, and complex.
53. **Georges Gardet Brut Rosé (Champagne)** £42.00  
Strawberry in colour, with soft red berry fruit flavours, and a delicious creamy finish.
54. **Laurent Perrier Brut (Champagne)** £45.00  
Medium bodied, Perfectly balanced and very easy on the palate. Finishes clean yet delicately lingers.
55. **Pol Roger Brut Vintage 1998 (Champagne)** £75.00  
An absolute star, dry but with superb ripe fruit and a deep complex palate. Easy to see why Winston Churchill favoured this House with his patronage!

## Verre du Vin

All our wines by the glass are kept in perfect condition by using the Verre du Vin wine preservation system which introduces a layer of inert gas into the bottle thereby preventing any loss of quality by oxidation. For Champagne the system equalises the pressure in the bottle and maintains the sparkle.
