The thirtieth meeting of the Bowmen of Wharfedale two-way Western was hosted at the grounds of the Bowmen of Adel and organised by Mr David Aikin. Forty archers presented themselves at the assembly which was addressed by the Field Captain Dr. Cedric Abbott. Although there was a heavy dew, the weather was dry with a gentle breeze, and the sun appeared from behind the clouds during the shooting.

The archers broke off from the shooting for a glass of sherry after two dozen arrows in the morning and again after two dozen arrows in the afternoon. Mr Aikin provided a luncheon of pie and peas followed by various deserts and tea or coffee. After the shoot, tea was served with cheese and cake and various sticky buns.

The prizes were awarded by the Lady Paramount, Mrs Ann Gaunt. As this was the 30<sup>th</sup> recorded shoot and the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Bowmen of Adel, award winners were also presented with silver medals celebrating the anniversary. The prize winners were as follows:
