3. The Judge will ride at their own discretion without giving an explanation.
4. The organisers has the right to refuse any entries without giving a reason
5. Any animal that kicks **MUST** wear a red ribbon on its tail at all times.
6. NO horse under four years of age to be ridden.
7. Owners, Competitors and Riders are under obligation at all times when mounted to ensure that they are wearing Protective Headgear complying with Current British Standards.
8. Body Protectors are advisable in Jumping Classes.
9. Lead Rein must be attached to Noseband in the Lead Rein Classes.
10. No refunds for classes which clash.
11. Any objections must be made as soon as possible at the Secretary's desk. A £10 deposit will be required but will be refunded if the complaint is upheld
12. Suitable footwear **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted or entering the ring
13. The Judge's decision is final.
14. **No Cantering in the show fields**
15. Dogs are allowed only on leads in the parking area. For the enjoyment of others please collect any mess.

SOUTH WEST PONY ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFYING RULES

To qualify for the Championships:

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes.
2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring.
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card.
4. Return the card to together with any registration fees due **within 14 days** of this show.

Directions

From Holsworthy

Head towards Bradworthy and on entering the square with the Bradworthy Inn on your Right continue straight through the village, just outside the village turn left at Crosspark cross signposted Dinworthy, Follow the road for approx ¾ mile and just past the turning for Kilkhampton turn right down the lane to Dinworthy Stables

From Bideford

Head towards Bradworthy and on entering the square turn Right towards Meddon continue straight through the village, just outside the village turn left at Crosspark cross signposted Dinworthy, Follow the road for approx ¾ mile and just past the turning for Kilkhampton turn right down the lane to Dinworthy Stables

From Bude

From the A39 towards Bideford turn right to Meddon and Bradworthy. Go through Meddon heading for Bradworthy, just outside the village turn Right at Crosspark Cross signposted Dinworthy, Follow the road for approx ¾ mile and just past the turning for Kilkhampton turn right down the lane to Dinworthy Stables
